

13th HOLE

LATERAL WATER HAZARD

Please note, with immediate effect, the status of the boundary around the 13th hole has been changed.

Laugherne Brook is now classed as a LATERAL WATER HAZARD.

If a ball enters, or crosses the boundary of Laugherne Brook, Rule 26-1c[1] must be applied - i.e.:-

" under the penalty of one stroke, a play may drop his ball outside the water hazard within two club lengths, but no nearer the hole.

When proceeding under this Rule, a player may lift and clean his ball, or substitute a ball."

The above alteration over-rides the current Local Rule [1b] which refers specifically to Hole 13 on the back of the course score-card .

New signage has been placed on the 13th tee.
