All players are reminded of the following, taken from The Rules of Golf, Section 1:-

### Pace of Play

" . . . where a group has not lost a clear hole, but it is apparent that the group behind can play faster, it should invite the faster moving group to play through"

### Also:-

### Priority on the Course

"Unless otherwise determined by the Committee, priority on the course is determined by the group's pace of play. Any group playing a whole round is entitled to pass a group playing a shorter round. The term "group" includes a single player".
